Currently, 39.1% of the 69,550 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 43.2%, renter occupied; and 17.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 11.4% are vacant. In 2010, there were 67,979 housing units in the area - 39.6% owner occupied, 42.4% renter occupied, and 18.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.02%. Median home value in the area is \$118,751, compared to a median home value of \$167,749 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.94% annually to \$137,266.
