Currently, 56.8% of the 29,765 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.2%, renter occupied; and 11.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 11.4% are vacant. In 2010, there were 28,456 housing units in the area - 57.0% owner occupied, 31.4% renter occupied, and 11.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.02%. Median home value in the area is \$172,855, compared to a median home value of \$167,749 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.63% annually to \$187,385.
